The after-school program started with 10 students and now supports over 400 students with educational support, mentoring career planning, mental health, and fostering better relationships between youth and their parents.

We eagerly launched the Reentry Youth Intervention Program, Substance Abuse Reduction Alliance, and A & A Swimming Institute.

PSCDG will continue to serve the community with passion and empower our young people by opening access to life-changing opportunities. I am honored to work with an amazing staff with the same passion and vision for our clients.


