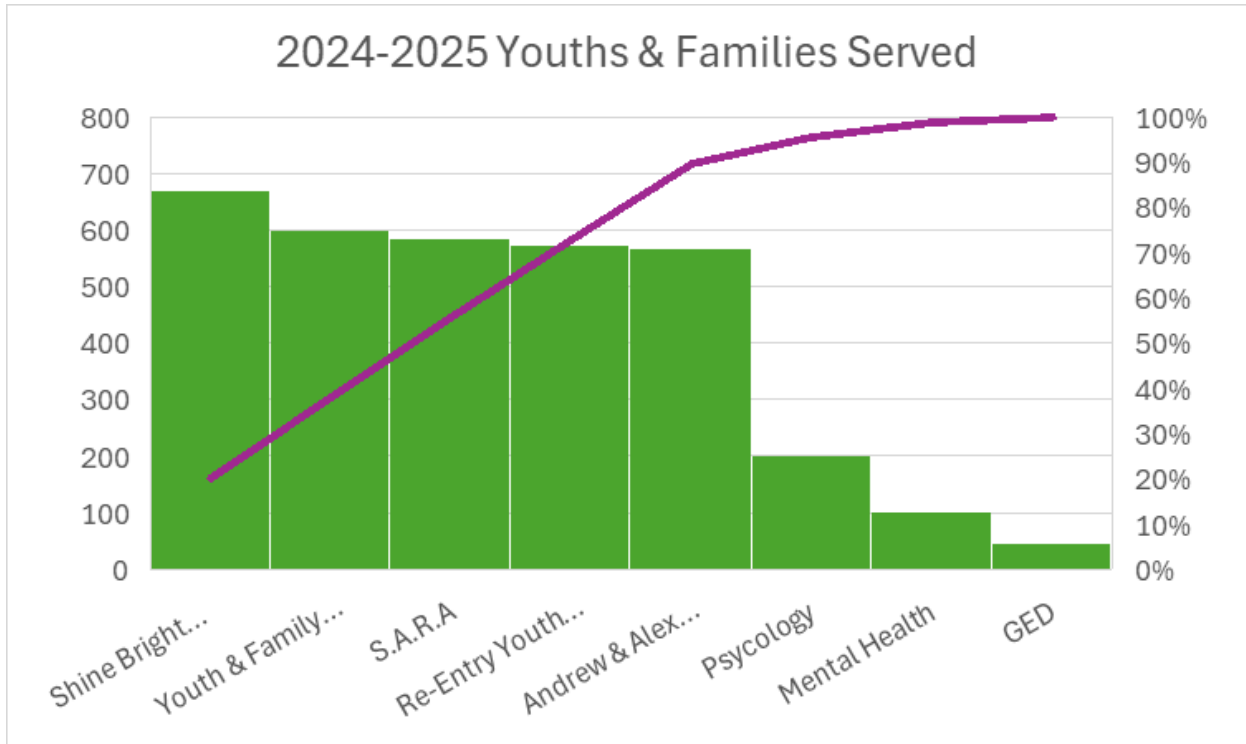

Prosperity Social & Community Development Group Inc. (PSCDG) is looking ahead to a year of growth and expansion. Our goals include securing our own building to create more space for programs and services that support families and youth.

PSCDG plans to expand into Broward County while increasing services across several cities in Miami-Dade County, allowing us to reach more families and youth in need. We also aim to expand transportation services next year to reduce access barriers.



A key focus of our future plans is the opening of the Youth Education Center (Y.E.S.), a safe and supportive learning environment designed to provide second chances for underserved, underrepresented, and at-risk youth. The center will serve young people who have left school, are system-involved, or face systemic barriers, empowering them to stand on our motto: “Y.E.S. — Yes, We Can Succeed.”
